Bulk stationery will be transported from where-ever area to the Eastern Cape warehouse/s (either owned jointly by the LED local partner, or local partner) across the districts as a warded by the department. 3. Picking and packing per grade, per school, per district will be executed in the local warehouse/s (the whole aim here is to create as many jobs as possible in the Eastern Cape) 4. The LTSM Agency will conduct from the local warehouse/s audits on quality, and quantity. 5. Local Distributors who will be facilitated by the Department and the LTSM Agency will collect the

Do we as the manufacturer and LED partner only deliver to warehouses and not to schools? Do we do any packing of stationery packs or are we to deliver stationery items only to allocated warehouse?	Picking and packing per grade, per school, per district will take place in your warehouse as a Local LED partner in the district/s awarded and the distributors will collect the readily packed stationery from your warehouse and deliver to schools.
	Included in the RFP are the following clauses: Where there is a partnership between the well- established stationery manufacturer (from outside the Eastern Cape Province) and the local (eastern cape- based partner). The outside Eastern Cape Province manufacturer /bidder must identify a Local LED partner that meet at
	requirements: 1. The local LED partner must be an EME or QSE
	which is at least 51% owned by black people.2. An EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people who are youth.
	EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people who are women.
	 An EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people with disabilities.
	5. An EME or QSE.
	6. Prospective well-established manufacturers coming from outside the Eastern Cape Province who in terms of partnership fail to meet at least one the above listed pre-qualifying criteria stipulated in the tender documents shall be disqualified.

Submission of Annual Financial Statements to a third-party entity appointed by the Eastern Cape Department of Education, for the facilitation of procurement of LTSM.	Prospective bidders who are not comfortable to submit their Annual Financial Statement or proof of financial capacity to the LTSM Agency (Libone Litho) must submit such in a separate clearly marked and sealed envelope before on the closing date in the Mandla Makupula Education Institute in Sterling. They must ensure that such is submitted before or on the closing date at 11h00. Failure to submit the Annual Financial Statements or proof of financial capacity as outlined in the RFP shall disqualify your bid.
Can prospective bidders have more than one Local LED partner?	This is discretionary, the prospective bidder may have more than one partner.
Joint B-BBEE certificate	JV arrangements must be concluded in order to have a joint B-BBEE certificate which must be included in the bid. All other criteria must still be adhered to as indicated in the bid.
