BINDING TERMS & CONDITIONS OF THE SALE

The purchaser shall be deemed to have, thoroughly examined the vehicles and have irrevocably accepted the condition and state thereof. The Department or its representatives gives no warranties or guarantees of or makes any representation in regards to the condition of sale of any vehicles. The Department shall not be liable for any errors of description of vehicles.
3.	The Department may accept or reject bids using its sole discretion without providing reasons. This would include rejecting an offer previously accepted by the Department. In the event of identical bids received, the Department will have the discretion to put the vehicle(s) up for auction again and its decision will be final and binding.
4.	On acceptance of offer to purchase the vehicle, payments should be made to the Departmental bank account within 14 days of confirming acceptance of offer. No arrangements for part-payments will be entertained.
5.	It will be the responsibility of the purchaser to collect vehicle at own cost within seven (07) days after payment is made.
6.	Vehicle registration papers will be issued to the new vehicle owner on receipt of proof that the vehicle is paid in full.
7.	The Eastern Cape Department of Education officials are allowed to participate in the auction of its assets.
8.	Only one vehicle will be permitted per successful bidder.
