- 1. The errors that were identified by the schools on the third preliminary schedules of learner entries for 2022 Grade 12 NSC examinations were effected in the examination system (IECS).
- However, it is worth mentioning that there are cases which were not effected on the system, for example, unauthorized subject changes, de-registrations (where enough supporting documents were not provided) and biographical data where there is no ID provided as the supporting document.
